ANCHORAGE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT ADMINISTRATION STAFF RELOCATION

Anchorage, Alaska

ANC is one of Anchorage’s most visible public facilities. USKH recently completed a behind-the-scenes but vital remodel for the ANC administration staff. The \$4.2 million dollar, 28,384-sf renovation provided new office space for airport staff on the third and fourth levels of the C Concourse at the airport and was constructed under budget. USKH provided programming through construction document services to DOT&PF.

The design reflects aviation themes and captures the panoramic views of the runways and Chugach Mountains. A majority of the office space is open with the few private offices being held back from the west window walls to allow maximum light to travel deep into the space. Privacy booths were provided within each department to compensate for the open office plan. On the fourth level, glass walls occur at all east/ west private offices and conference rooms, to maximize views and natural daylight. A bright color was used on the exterior wall of the break rooms to provide visual clues when traveling through departments. USKH also provided FF&E services for this tenant improvement.
