USKH is providing project management, cadastral retracement, ALTA surveys, route surveys, and boundary surveys for a 100,000-acre facility in south central Washington, as well as providing staking for power generation and power transmission structures.

The project is slated to last five years, and we completed the first year's activities in November 2009. Detailed orthophotography of the entire site has been delivered, and design engineering for the project is complete for phase one of the project. Construction of access roads and turbines is underway. USKH will be engaged as project surveyors for the entire five-year project.

Included within the scope of this work were topographic surveys for multiple substation sites.
