USKH was contracted by the DOT&PF in 2009 to monument the proposed runway and access road in preparation for construction of the new Ouzinkie Airport. USKH set 118 monuments, which included PCs, PIs, PTs, RPs, and runway centerline monuments. A combination of GPS and conventional survey methods were used; due to terrain and dense vegetation, 90-percent of this project was surveyed using conventional methods. USKH was intimately familiar with the area from our design survey efforts performed from 2003 to 2005, which included a large control, topographic, and right-of-way survey with a fee exceeding \$300,000.
