# MAGNUSON BUILDING RENOVATION

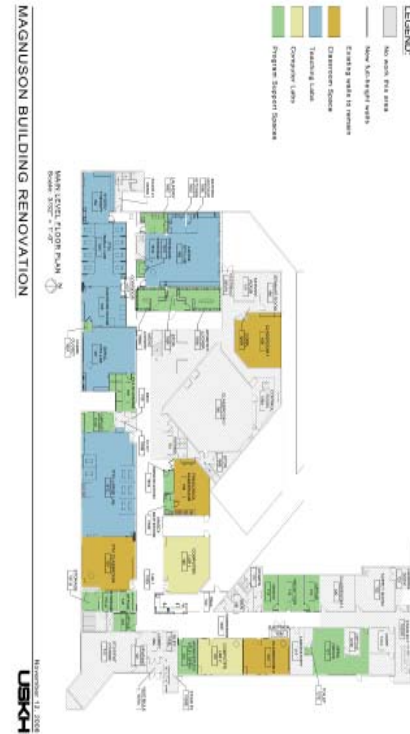
## Spokane, Washington

The Washington State General Administration and Spokane Falls Community College (SFCC) selected USKH was selected to develop the distance-learning capacity of their new nursing and physical therapy programs within an existing building.

The Magnuson Building was constructed 1979-1980 to house the Intercollegiate School of Nursing (ICSN). The ICSN is a cooperative effort between regional post secondary educational facilities to provide nursing education. The nursing school programs moved to a new facility in fall of '08', leaving the Magnuson Building available for new tenants. Building ownership was transferred from Washington State University to the Community Colleges of Spokane (CCS). CCS will use the building Allied Health Programs and The Institute for Extended Learning Programs (IEL).

Preparing the Magnuson Building for the CCS programs required alterations to areas of the first and second floors. First floor alterations include transforming several small seminar rooms into classrooms, creating open office suites from partitioned areas, along with providing data communication for offices and audio/visual enhancements for the classrooms. Other improvements include providing existing classrooms with data and power connections to allow the space to be used as computer labs.

Improvements on the second floor include partitioning the open floor area of the library into computer labs and classrooms for the IEL Programs and providing audio/visual enhancements to the newly formed classrooms and computer labs.
